DAY 1 SINGAPORE 🛪 XI AN

Gather at Changi Airport, take a flight to the ancient capital Xi'an. Upon arrival, a local guide will meet the group, and a private car will be arranged to transfer to the hotel for check-in and rest.

DAY 2 XI AN - MOUNT HUA

Visit the **Qin Shi Huang Terracotta Army** in **Xi'an**, then travel by car (1 hour) to Lintong, visit **Huaqing Palace**, and finally, travel by car (1.5 hours) to **Mount Hua**.

- The Terracotta Army of Qin Shi Huang It is the imperial tomb of Qin Shi Huang, the first emperor of China's Qin Dynasty. Here, visitors can admire vivid and lifelike terracotta warriors and horses, each with different expressions and poses. Additionally, various types of bronze weapons and Qin dynasty pottery figurines are on display. The awe-inspiring artistic power of the Terracotta Army stems not only from its lifelike representations but also from its grand scale and majestic presence, earning it the title of the "Eighth Wonder of the World." (Includes electric cart + audio guide)
- Huaqing Pool a hot spring bath in Huaqing Palace during the Tang Dynasty, known for its hot springs, scenery, and the love story of Emperor Xuanzong and Yang Guifei. Includes Huaqing Palace Imperial Hot Spring Site Museum and the Xi'an Incident Site.

DAY 3 MOUNT HUA - HANCHENG

Mount Hua - Travel by car (3 hours) to Hancheng.

- After breakfast, visit Mount Hua (including the North Peak cable car ride up and down) Mount Hua, formerly known as "Western Great Mountain," is one of China's famous Five Great Mountains. It is renowned as the "most precipitous mountain under heaven," featuring magnificent and perilous peaks that rise steeply with towering cliffs. Mount Hua has five main peaks: the North Peak (Cloud Terrace Peak), East Peak (Morning Sun Peak), South Peak (Falling Goose Peak), West Peak (Lotus Flower Peak), and Middle Peak (Jade Maiden Peak). The famous "Mount Hua Sword Test" takes place on the North Peak of Mount Hua.
- Hancheng Explore the ancient city of Hancheng with Ming and Qing Dynasty-era streets, ancient buildings, and traditional courtyard residences. It is among the well-preserved ancient cities from the Ming and Qing Dynasties in China.

Hancheng Ancient City, Party Village - Travel by car (3 hours) to Hukou, Hukou Waterfall.

- **Party Village** This ancient village is comprised of numerous "siheyuan" (traditional courtyard houses) of varying sizes. With a history spanning six hundred and seventy years, the village's roads are paved with large stones, presenting a grand and imposing appearance. The siheyuan, all adorned with gray tiles and blue bricks, are interconnected with adjoining roofs and walls, creating an impressive overall architectural composition. The entire village exudes a serene and solemn ancient charm.
- Hukou Waterfall (including electric cart) "Have you not seen the waters of the Yellow River coming from heaven, rushing onwards to the sea, never to return? Suddenly, they shrink into a pot, and then surge forth." The surging Yellow River reaches this point, where its width of over 500 meters is abruptly constrained by the surrounding banks. The river narrows from top to bottom and tumbles and rushes over a 50-meter drop, creating a spectacle akin to water pouring out from a vast and incomparable pot. The mouth of the river narrows like the neck of a pot, hence the name "Hukou Waterfall." Described in the ancient Chinese book "Shangshu Yugong," it says, "The whirlpool of the river is like a pot." Two famous phenomena, "sailing on dry land" and "smoke rising from the water," are also rare sights here.

DAY 5 HUKOU - YAN AN

Hukou - Travel by car (3.5 hours) to Yan'an, Zao Yuan Revolutionary Site.

• Zaoyuan Revolutionary Site - It is a garden-style revolutionary memorial site, often referred to as the "Little Zhongnanhai of Yan'an." Zaoyuan was the former site of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, located in Zaoyuan Village, 8 kilometers northwest of the city. Here, visitors can see cave dwellings typical of the Loess Plateau in northern Shaanxi. These cave dwellings, known as "yaodongs," represent an ancient form of residence for inhabitants of the Loess Plateau in northwest China, with a history dating back over four thousand years.

DAY 6 YAN AN

HOTEL (LOCAL 5大)

Yan'an - Travel by car (2.5 hours) to Jingbian, Yuhuang Valley, then return (2.5 hours) to Yan'an.

• Jingbian Longzhou - Visit the Longzhou Danxia Landform, renowned as the "Wave Valley" of China. The red sandstone formations of Longzhou Danxia are mostly covered by thick loess. Over millions of years of wind erosion and seasonal heavy rains on the Loess Plateau of northern Shaanxi, the red sandstone peaks gradually emerged and were sculpted into various shapes by the forces of nature, forming the rare red sandstone landscape seen today. Often referred to as the "Little Zhongnanhai of Yan'an," Zaoyuan was the former site of the Central Committee of the Communist Party of China, located in Zaoyuan Village, 8 kilometers northwest of the city. Here, visitors can see cave dwellings typical of the Loess Plateau in northern Shaanxi. These cave dwellings, known as "yaodongs," represent an ancient form of residence for inhabitants of the Loess Plateau in northwest China, with a history dating back over four thousand years.

DAY 7 YAN AN - XI AN 🛪 SINGAPORE

Yan'an - Travel by car (2.5 hours) to Ganquan, then travel by car (3.5 hours) to Xi'an.

- Ganquan Yucha Grand Canyon Located in Yucha Gou, Xiasiwan Town, Ganquan County, Yan'an City, Shaanxi Province, it is characterized by red sandstone geological formations. Formed through millions of years of wind erosion, water erosion, and abrasion on the Loess Plateau of northern Shaanxi, it is rare in China and is referred to as the "Natural Fissure Wonder of the Loess Plateau." (Includes shuttle transportation)
- Bell and Drum Tower Square Located at the intersection of four main streets running east, west, south, and north, the square is home to the historic Bell Tower, which has stood for over six hundred years on the eastern side, and the largest Drum Tower in the country on the western side. Surrounded by numerous shops, it is an important leisure destination for tourists.
- **Muslim Quarter** The district features buildings in the style of ancient Ming and Qing dynasties. Walking through it, you'll find bluestone pavement, hanging gold plaques, bustling old streets, and the aroma of delicious food wafting through the air. Xi'an's unique blend of ancient city charm and modern civilization is showcased in this historical and cultural district. Additionally, you can enjoy Shaanxi's specialty foods and snacks at your own expense.
- Datang Everbright City It is the only large-scale imitation Tang-style architectural complex in the country, with the Tang Dynasty culture as its background. The pedestrian street is based on the cultural relics of the Sui and Tang Dynasties, with the Silk Road culture and the prosperous Tang Dynasty culture as its main themes, forming an ancient-style shopping street.
- Early morning flight to Singapore.
