DAY 1  
SINGAPORE ✈️ BARCELONA

Embark on your flight to start your trip.

DAY 2  
BARCELONA (D)

**Montjuic Hill** is a 230-metre-high hill overlooking Barcelona from the South-east and opening the best views over the port, Barcelona city and coastline.

**Sagrada Familia (Entrance Ticket Included)** is a large unfinished minor basilica in the district of Barcelona. It is currently the largest unfinished Roman Catholic Church.

**National Museum + Olympic Stadium**

**Las Ramblas** is often the first landmark that most tourists identify with the city. It is a large boulevard which runs through the heart of the city centre.

DAY 3  
BARCELONA (B)

**La Roca Village**, home to over 150 boutiques of world-leading fashion and lifestyle brands - all offering year-round savings.

DAY 4  
BARCELONA - VALENCIA (B/D)

**Serrango City Gates** - These imposing gate towers create an exceptional atmosphere and are a magnificent example of Gothic Architecture.

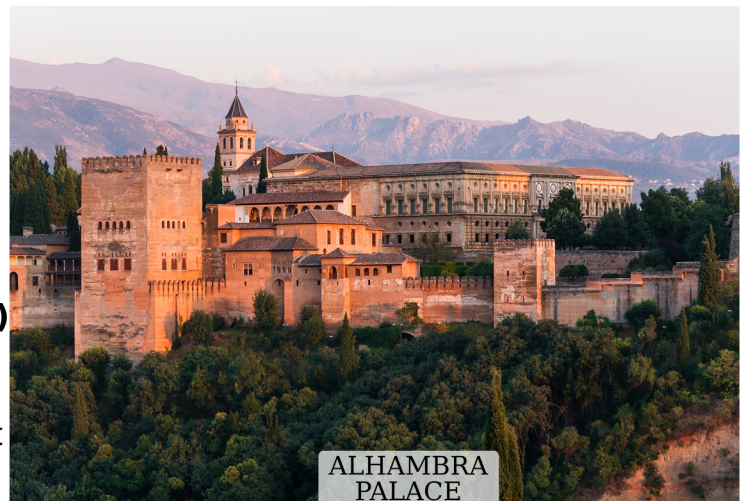
**Arts & Science Museum** is one of the largest scientific and cultural complexes in Europe.

**Valencia Cathedral** is at a greater length of the metropolitan Cathedral-Basilica of the Assumption of our Lady of Valencia.

DAY 5  
VALENCIA - GRANADA (B/D)

**Alhambra Palace (Entrance Ticket Included)** is one of the most famous monuments of Islamic Architecture.

**Palace Gardens** are composed of anything that can provide pleasure to the five senses: Colour, Light, Aromatic plants and the murmur of water.



**DAY 6**  
**GRANADA - GIBRALTAR - SEVILLE** (B/D)

**Rock of Gibraltar** is a limestone ridge that rises sharply from the surrounding area with panoramic views of the sea, Spain & Morocco on clear days.

**St. Michael's Cave** is a network of limestone caves and tunnels within the Rock of Gibraltar.

**Europa Tower** is the southern most point of Gibraltar, offering views of the Strait of Gibraltar & the African coastline.

Visit **Mezquita (Entrance ticket Included)**, the Cathedral of the Roman Catholic Diocese, dedicated to the Assumption of Mary, located in the Spanish region of Andalusia.



Afterwards, see the **Old Jewish Quarter** that overflows with history & legends. **Giralda Tower**, the bell tower of Seville Cathedral, which was built as the minaret of the Great Mosque of Seville.

**Seville Cathedral** is a Roman Catholic Cathedral that was registered in 1987 by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. **Plaza de Espana** is a plaza that was built in 1928 for the Ibero-American Exposition of 1929.



**DAY 7**  
**SEVILLE - LISBON** (B/D)

After Cordova, you will be heading to Lisbon where you can see the **Jeronimo's Monastery**, one of the most prominent examples of the Portuguese Late Gothic Manueline Style of Architecture in Lisbon.

**Rossio Square** is located in the heart of Lisbon and it is bursting with flower vendors.

**Discover Monument** was built to celebrate the 500th Anniversary of the death of Henry the Navigator.

**Belem Tower** is a 16th Century fortification located in Lisbon that served as a point of embarkation and disembarkation for Portuguese explorers and as a ceremonial gateway to Lisbon.



**DAY 8**  
**LISBON - FATIMA - PORTO** (B/D)

Head straight to Fatima and visit the **Sanctuary of Fatima**; officially titled Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Rosary of Fatima.

Afterwards, explore Porto where you can see the **Luis I Bridge**, a double-deck metal arch bridge that spans the river Douro between the cities of Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia in Portugal.

**Porto Cathedral** is one of the city's oldest monuments. **Porto Stock Exchange Palace** is a historical building that was built in the 19th century by the city's Commercial Association in Neoclassical style.



**DAY 9**  
**PORTO - SALAMANCA** (B/D)

**Salamanca Cathedral** was constructed between the 16th and 18th Centuries in two styles: Late Gothic and Baroque.

**Salamanca University**, the oldest university in the Hispanic world, founded in 1218 by King Alfonso IX.

**Plaza Mayor** is located in the centre; used as a Public Square.

**DAY 10** (B/L)  
**SALAMANCA -AVILA -SEGOVIA -MADRID**

**Avila Fortress** was completed between 11th & 14th century. These fortifications are the most completed in all of Spain.

While roaming, you can experience Segovia by visiting the **Roman Aqueduct**, the best preserved elevated roman aqueducts and the foremost symbol of Segovia.

**Segovia Cathedral** is the Gothic-Style roman Catholic Cathedral in the community of Castile-Leon Spain; while **Alcazar of Segovia** is a medieval castle located in the same city.



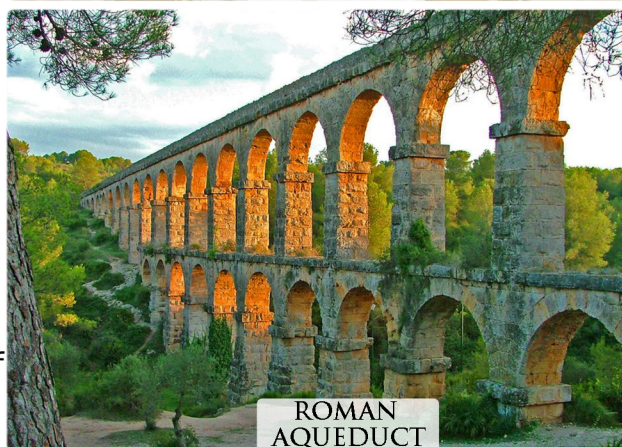

Finally, enjoy **Las Rozas Village**, home to more than 100 boutiques in the world.

**DAY 11**  
**MADRID** (B/L)

Roam around the city of Madrid where you can visit one of the largest department stores, **El Corte Ingles** for your shopping spree.

**Royal Palace (Entrance Inclusive)** has 135,000m<sup>2</sup> of floor space and contains 3,418 rooms. It is the largest functioning Royal Palace and floor area in Europe.
