DAY 2 ROME - VATICAN CITY - ROME (D)

View the famous **Colosseum**, the largest amphitheatre built during the Roman Empire. You can also see the **Trevi Fountain** designed by Italian architect Nicola salvi and it was completed by Pietro Bracci. End your tour at **Spanish Steps Shopping** around Piazza di Spagna, one of the main attraction in Rome.

Move to **Vatican City** to view the **St. Peter's Basilica**, church built in the Renaissance style and the **St. Peter's Square**, the papal enclave and west neighborhood of Rione of Borgo.

DAY 3 ROME-PISA-FLORENCE-TUSCANY


Leaning Tower of Pisa is a city in Tuscany Region best knows for its iconic leaning tower. Already titling when it was completed in 1372. The 56m white-marble cylinder is the Bell Tower of the Romanesque, striped-marble cathedral that rises next to it.

Florence Cathedral was begun in 1296 in the Gothic style to a design of Arnolfo di Cambio.

Visit the **Gates of Paradise** right in front of the Cathedral and **Piazza Signoria**, an L-shape square in front of the **Palazzo Vecchio** in Florence.















DAY 4 TUSCANY - VENICE

Explore the **Venice** by visiting the **St. Mark's Basilica**, the Cathedral church of the Roman Catholic Patriarchate of Venice. While you're in the area, you can also see the **St. Mark's Square** also known as **La Piazza**. You can also visit the Glass Blowing Factory and you have an option to ride the Gondola to see the famous Venice Canal and **The Bridge of Sighs**. Lastly, visit a **Glass Blowing Factory** and discover the art of glass blowing.


DAY 6 MILAN - LUCERNE - ZURICH
