

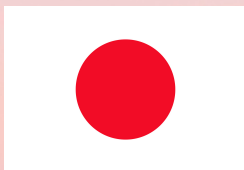

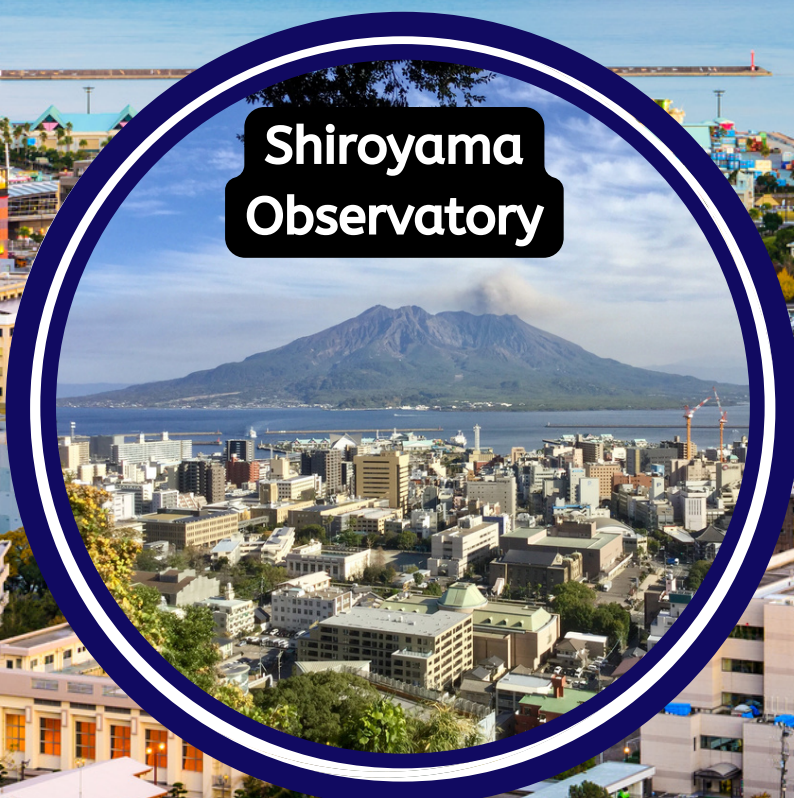

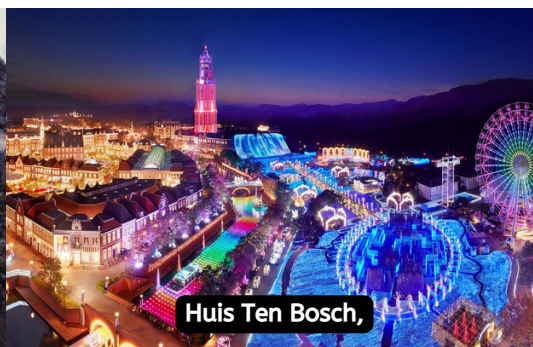

Ashiyu (Hot Foot Spa)

Nagasaki

- **Huis Ten Bosch** - is an extensive theme park where a medieval Dutch townscape has been recreated. In English, Huis Ten Bosch means "House in the forest."
- **Nagasaki Chinatown** - The town was home for many Chinese sailors and traders who trade goods with the Japanese from the 15th to 19th centuries.
- **Ashiyu (Hot Foot Spa)** - a foot spa that is usually formed with a small bathing pool filled with hot spring water, often set under a wooden canopy where people sit around and soak their feet in relaxation
- **Unzen Jigoku** - also known as Unzen Hell, is one of the best places to enjoy natural hot spring in Nagasaki Prefecture.
- **Shimabara Ochaya Shima** - Through the long history of this OCHAYA, the name has changed many times. It is now called "SHIMA" (goodwill of the guest house).

Kumamoto - Kagoshima - Ibusuki

- **Kumamoto** - Kumamoto City embodies the rich culture, natural beauty, and stimulating flavors of Kyushu.
- **Shiroyama Observatory** - Great spot for viewing Sakurajima and the site of the last fierce battle of samurai warriors.
- **Sengan-en** - also known as Isoteien, is a Japanese-style landscape garden along the coast north of downtown Kagoshima.
- **Chiran Samurai District**- there is a preserved samurai district with houses and gardens that date back about 250 years.
- **Cape Nagasakibana** - Cape Nagasakibana is the southernmost point of the Satsuma Peninsula.
- **Kagoshima Bay** - which is more commonly known as Kinko Bay. The smoking Sakurajima centered in Kinko Bay is one of the main symbols of Kagoshima Prefecture.
- **Lake Ikeda** - is a caldera lake located 40 km south of Kagoshima city; Kyūshū island, Japan.
- **Sakurajima Island** - Sakurajima is an active volcano and island, which has come to symbolize Kagoshima
- **Arimura Lava Observatory** - located at the southern foot of Sakurajima Island which was made on the lava field of 1914 in Arimura Village.
- **Sakamoto Kurozu Inc** - Sakamoto Kurozu", Artisan Amber Rice Vinegar is made from a unique technique, known for its mellow taste and health-promoting benefits.

Kirishima - Mt Aso

- **Kirishima Shrine** - is a Shinto shrine dedicated to Ninigi no Mikoto, who plays a role in Japanese creation mythology.
- **Kirishima Hot-Spring Village** - Kirishima Onsen, a famous hot spring resort in southern Kyushu.
- **Mt Aso Kusasenri** - A grassy plateau sits atop the five peaks of Mt Aso, one of Japan's most impressive volcanoes.
- **Ebino Yahataoka Park and Suizenji Park** - the origins of this garden date back to 1632, when Tadatoshi Hosokawa from the first generation of local lords, who ruled Higo Province, built Suizenji Temple by the lake here.

Mt Aso - Beppu - Fukuoka

- **Kokonoe "Yume" Grand Suspension Bridge** - Japan's longest and loftiest pedestrian bridge, it presents panoramic scenes of Oita's verdant countryside, including two waterfalls, the Naruko River and the valley 173 meters below.
- **Daikanbo** - which means large observatory, is named for its panoramic views of the five central peaks of Mt. Aso, and Oita's Kuju Mountain range.
- **Chinoike-jigoku** - (Blood Pond Hell) is the oldest natural hell in Japan and is best described as "a pool of red-hot mud".
- **Yufuin Onsen** - the leading Hot Spring Resort of Japan. The hot springs that abound in the town of Yufuin are divided into three distinct areas which is Yufuin Hot Springs, Yunohira Hot Springs and Tsukahara Hot Springs.
- **Tosu Premier Outlets** - for a wide range of branded merchandise at discount prices. Some popular brands include Coach, Burberry, Ralph Lauren, Tommy Hilfiger, Timberland and etc.
- **Dazaifu Tenmangu** - a famous shrine enveloped with 6,000 plum trees.
- **Canal Hakata Bay** - This complex is a miniaturised city within a city, with everything from a movie theatre and amusement park to restaurants and shops.
